The Power of Influence

Time to Come Back



A few days later, when Jesus again entered Capernaum, the people heard that he had come home. They gathered in such large numbers that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on

- Wait till he comes out
- He can't Heal him!
- Jesus will reject us because of vandalism
- Just one non believer! (Influence of negativity)

Self-Preservation vs. Faith!

Psychological research suggests that the negative bias influences motivation to complete a task. People have less motivation when an incentive is framed as a means to gain something than when the same incentive will help them avoid the loss of something (Verywellmind.com)

Evil is Alive and at Work!

We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing. Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.

So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me (Romans 7:14-21)

Hardwired

When you have a negative, fear based, shameful experience or an insecure thought, your mind wraps around it like velcro. When you have a positive experience, for example – when you receive a compliment or somebody affirms and congratulations you, it slides off like melted butter on a teflon skillet. Our brains are hardwired to record negative experiences and quickly forget positive experiences.

The human mind is attracted to the negative. It's why we get so caught up in gossip. It's why bad news is good for ratings. Humiliation sticks with us for days. Shame and hurt can stick with us for years. But we are not nearly as affected by the positive feedback we receive

Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, "Why are you thinking these things?

(Mark 2:5-6)

Jesus' Concern

- His condition of his Heart (Lust, Forgive, Self)
- Thinking of Eternity
- Mobility for Life but in Hell for Eternity!
- Get Forgiven of sins is first!
- How do I view people?
- Do I look at the physical only?
- Many people are physically sound but paralyzed spiritually!
- What would Jesus say to you?
- No Shallowship (How are you doing spiritually?)

Am I Spiritually Paralyzed?

I Tell You, Get Up!

Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, "Why are you thinking these things? Which is easier: to say to this paralyzed man, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up, take your mat and walk'? But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So he said to the man, "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." He got up, took his mat and walked out in full view of them all. This amazed everyone and they praised God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this!" Mark 2:8-12
